Dear First Presbyterian Church Family,

One of my favorite Bible passages is from the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 7:

⁷ "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened."

In the context of this Gospel, the passage follows Jesus' proclamation of the Lord's Prayer and His question to us, "²⁷ Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life^[e]?" For the joy we feel as we gather for Sunday School and Worship each Sabbath Day.




The Lay Readers for January for the 9am service are Russ and Lynn Knight and for the 11am service, it is Brad Marin.
